1. The present first petition has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (corresponding to Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973), seeking issuance of appropriate directions to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to strictly comply with the mandate of Section 179 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (corresponding to Section 160 Cr.P.C., 1973), by serving a written notice upon the petitioner in accordance with law in the event his presence is required by the investigating agency in connection with any criminal case, inquiry, or proceeding. A further direction is sought that the petitioner shall

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not be compelled, coerced, or forced to appear before the police authorities except in accordance with the procedure prescribed under Section 179 of the BNSS, 2023, and that he shall be afforded all safeguards available under law while joining investigation in any criminal case, inquiry, or proceeding.

2. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail alternate remedy, available to him in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

4. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stands disposed of.
