1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the orders dated 28.02.2008 (Annexure P-6) and 02.02.2012 (Annexure P-9), whereby the monthly compassionate financial assistance was withdrawn.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that a perusal of the written statement dated 18.12.2018 filed by Ashok Kumar, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Telecommunication, Haryana, Panchkula would show that in para No.10, it has been mentioned that the similar case is pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court in CA No.2144 of 2016 in which the operation of the judgment of the Division Bench has been stayed. Reference was also made to LPA Nos.690 and 2063 of 2017 which were pending before this Court. He further submits that the issue pending in the Hon'ble Supreme Court has already been decided vide judgment dated 13.02.2020 and the above referred LPAs have also been decided on

22.07.2020. He further submits that as the issue has already been decided by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the present writ petition may be disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner in light of the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in CA No.2144 of 2016 decided on 13.02.2020.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents does not oppose the prayer made by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner.

4. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to re-consider the case of the petitioner for grant of compassionate financial assistance in light of the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in CA No. 2144 of 2016 decided on 13.02.2020 within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order in accordance with law.

5. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of accordingly.
