KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (ORAL)

1. Through the instant petition, as instituted under Section 482 of the B.N.S.S., the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in Criminal Complaint No. NACT-3890-2023 under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, titled “Gaurav Bansal vs. M/s Durga Das Naresh Kumar”.

2. At the outset, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings before the trial Court and to remain present on each and every date of hearing. He, therefore, seeks leave to withdraw the instant petition, with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and move an application for bail, which may be directed to be decided expeditiously.

3. Leave granted.

4. Consequently, the instant petition is **dismissed as withdrawn**, with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within a

period of 10 days from today. In the event of such surrender, and upon an application for bail being moved by the petitioner, the trial Court shall endeavour to consider and decide the same on the very same day, after affording an opportunity of hearing to the opposite party.
