The present application has been filed under Section 528 BNSS, 2023 (Corresponding Section 482 Cr.P.C.) for placing on record affidavit of Philfas Masih, regarding change of his religion from Christian to Hindu.

Allowed, as prayed for. Affidavit is ordered to be place on record. Registry is directed to place the same at an appropriate place.

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**Main**

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioners have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 8 and they claim themselves to be major and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 8. They have placed on record marriage certificate (Annexure P-3) to substantiate their claim. The petitioners have also submitted a representation dated 06.06.2026 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2 but no action has been taken so far.

3. Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

4. Mr. Vikas Sonak, learned Assistant Advocate General who is present in Court, accepts notice for the official respondents. Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to supply a copy of complete paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

5. Without commenting on validity of the marriage allegedly performed by the petitioners and entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of this petition with direction to respondent No.2 to decide representation of the petitioners (Annexure P-5) within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order and grant them protection, if there is

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any threat to their life and liberty. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law, if any committed by them.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stands disposed of.
