Instant application has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya
Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short, 'BNSS') seeking permission to
withdraw the main petition with liberty to file before the learned Sessions Court.

Learned counsel for applicant/petitioner, *inter alia*, contends that
during the pendency of the petition, a compromise has been effected between the
petitioner and the prosecutrix, as such he wishes to withdraw the present petition
