1. The present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing respondents No.4 to 6 to release the petitioner on regular parole for eight weeks as per the entitlement under Section 3(1)(A)(D) of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962.
