1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus, directing respondents No.1 & 2 to consider the candidature of the petitioner for appointment to the post of Clerk as per advertisement No.2 of 2016.

2. Learned State counsel, while referring to para 4 of the reply filed on behalf of respondents No.1 & 2, submits that the candidature of the petitioner for appointment to the post of Clerk has been cancelled, vide order dated 21.04.2016 (Annexure R-4) and the said order has not been challenged by the petitioner.

3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner, wishes to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file fresh one on the same cause of action by impugning the order dated 21.04.2016 (Annexure R-4), whereby the candidature of the petitioner has been cancelled.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
