1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the official respondents to consider and decide the representations dated 29.05.2026 (Annexure P-4) and 02.06.2026 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioners against the encroachment upon and an unauthorized utilisation of the petitioners' land and further prayed for issuance of appropriate directions restraining the respondents from carrying out any further constructions, activity, widening of the drain (nala), excavation, demolition or any other activity resulting in further encroachment, alteration of, or interference with the petitioners' land.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have filed representations dated 29.05.2026 (Annexure P-4) and 02.06.2026 (Annexure P-5) before the respondents raising their grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon.

In view of the prayer made by the petitioners, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 3 to decide the aforesaid representations dated 29.05.2026 (Annexure P-4) and 02.06.2026 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioners within a period of 15 days from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
