Prayer in the instant contempt petition, filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for non-compliance of the order dated 14.01.2026 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No.411 of 2026.

2. Today, Mr. Abhilaksh Gaind, Advocate, appears on behalf of respondent No.3 (Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana) and has handed over in Court a photocopy of the order dated 30.06.2026 passed by the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana. Same is taken on

record, subject to all just exceptions. Another copy thereof is also supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners in Court today itself.

3. Learned counsel for respondent No.3, while referring to the aforesaid order dated 30.06.2026, submits that the order dated 14.01.2026 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No.411 of 2026 has already been complied with. The said fact is also not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, no further orders are required to be passed in the instant contempt petition and the same is, accordingly, disposed of; however, leaving it open to the petitioners to avail their remedies, in accordance with law, against the aforesaid order dated 30.06.2026 (if so advised).
