1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order dated 28.05.2019 passed by respondent No.2 and notice dated 14.08.2019 (Annexure P-7) issued by respondent No.4.

2. Learned counsel for the private respondents has submitted that notice/order dated 14.08.2019 (Annexure P-7) has been passed under Section 216 of the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act and the same is appealable under Section 216(3) of the said Act. It is further submitted that as far as

the order dated 28.05.2019 is concerned, the same has not been annexed alongwith the present writ petition.

3. Today, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioners in order to rebut the abovesaid objection raised by learned counsel for the private respondents. No one had appeared on behalf of the petitioners on 07.04.2022 also.
