1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the notice dated 30.07.2022 (Annexure P-7) issued by respondent No.5 i.e. the Superintendent of Police, Nuh and the order dated 12.8.2022 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.6 i.e. the Superintendent of Police, Rewari, vide which, the petitioner was ordered to be compulsory retired from service w.e.f. 11.11.2022 (A.N.) at the age of 56 years.

2. A perusal of the order dated 14.09.2022 passed by this Court would show that the operation of the impugned order dated 12.08.2022 (Annexure P-8), vide which, the petitioner was directed to be relieved on 11.11.2022 (A.N.) was stayed.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been convicted by the competent Court vide order dated 28.02.2023 and on the basis of conviction, the petitioner has been

Superintendent of Police, Rewari. In light of the abovesaid facts, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the present writ petition may be disposed of as rendered infructuous.

4. In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of as rendered infructuous.
