1. This is a civil writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing respondents No.1 and 2 to re-issue the passport to the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.1 and 2 has submitted that the passport of the petitioner has already been dispatched to the petitioner and thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
