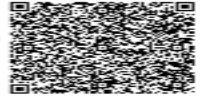

1. By way of filing this petition, the petitioners seek necessary protection of their lives and personal liberty in view of the fact that they are in a live-in relationship and are under imminent threat at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 10.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are in a live-in relationship against the wishes of respondent No. 4 and have sought protection to their lives and liberty. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No. 1- Aaysha , aged about 27 years is already married to respondent No. 4 and out of the said wedlock, four children were born. Now petitioner No. 1 started leaving away from the company of respondent No. 4 and at present, she is staying in live-in relationship with petitioner No. 2-Inamulhasam, aged about 39 years, who is also married with respondent No. 10 and having six children out of the said wedlock, against the wishes of private respondents No. 4 to 10. Thus, they have sought protection to their lives and liberty.

3. In the context of threat perception at the hands of private



respondents No. 4 to 10, the petitioners have allegedly moved a representation dated 18.06.2026, (Annexure P-3), to the Superintendent of Police, Nuh, Mewat, Haryana (respondent No. 2), wherein, all the apprehension to their lives have been expressed.

4. Notice of motion.

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rahul Dev, Additional Advocate General, Haryana who is present in Court, accept notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 (State).

6. Since petitioners have not contracted any marriage and seek only protection *qua* their lives and personal liberty, and for the same already representation dated 18.06.2026, (Annexure P-3), is pending, it would be appropriate to direct respondent No. 2 to have a fair look to the said representation, on the grievance of the petitioners in order to ascertain veracity of allegations made by them.

7. Respondent No. 2 would be at liberty to devise his/her own mechanism to ascertain the truth. He/she would also be at liberty to join the petitioners or any other person acquainted with facts in issue. If the assertion of the petitioners is established, respondent No. 2 shall proceed to take appropriate action in order to protect their lives and personal liberty from being invaded by private respondents No. 4 to 10.

8. This order is passed at this stage without commenting anything on the status of the petitioners on the basis of live-in relationship. Respondent No. 2 would pass necessary order without being influenced by any statement of fact recorded here-in-above.

9. Petition stands **disposed of** accordingly.
