SANJAY VASHISTH, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, for quashing of FIR No. 484, dated 23.07.2020 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149, 506 of IPC and Section 307 of IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Shivaji Colony, Rohtak, Haryana (Annexure P-1), and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise dated 17.05.2022 (Annexure P-2), effected between the parties.

2. Learned counsel appearing for private respondents No.2 to 4 submits that there is no compromise between the parties. Rather, it is contended that even after filing of the present petition, daughter of the complainant – Jai Parkash, was given beatings by the petitioner side.

3. That being the position, this Court does not find any substantial reason to keep the present petition pending before this Court.



4. Apparently, no genuine compromise exists between the parties. Thus, instant petition seeking quashing on the basis of compromise **stands dismissed, at this stage.**
