1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to grant the benefit of conveyance allowance to the petitioner with effect from 15.06.1982, when such benefits have been extended to the blinds and orthopaedically handicapped employees in view of the instructions/letter issued by the Government from time to time. Further, a writ of certiorari has been sought for quashing the instructions dated 22.05.2017 (Annexure P-15) to the extent which has been applied with immediate effect to the category of deaf and dumb employees, whereas the same should be applied from the date when the benefit of conveyance allowance was allowed to the same persons i.e. 15.06.1982 in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *CWP No.107 of 2011 titled as 'Deaf Employees Welfare Association & another v. Union of India &*

others', decided on 12.12.2013 (Annexure P-13).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has unfortunately died during the pendency of the present petition and legal representatives are not interested to pursue the present petition and he may be permitted to withdraw the same.
