1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction, particularly in the nature of *Certiorari* for quashing the orders dated 18.08.2009 (Annexure P-5), 29.09.2009 (Annexure P-7), 06.05.2010 (Annexure P-9) and 21.05.2010 (Annexure P-10) passed by respondents No.2, 3, 5 and 6 respectively, being illegal, arbitrary and passed in violation of the applicable statutory provisions and principles governing the matter. It



is the case of the petitioner that the impugned orders have resulted in grave miscarriage of justice and caused irreparable loss to the petitioner, while the actual beneficiaries and persons responsible for the alleged misconduct were left untouched and the entire liability and stigma have been fastened upon the petitioner alone, who is now a retired senior citizen dependent solely upon his pension.

2. Mr. Raina S. Thakur, Advocate has filed Power of Attorney on behalf of the respondent-PSPCL in the Court today, which is ordered to be taken on record. Registry is directed to place the same at an appropriate place.

3. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present writ petition.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stands disposed of.
