AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

As agreed, (statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for both the Insurance Companies having 50% liability of each Insurance Company, separately recorded) a sum of Rs.36,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty Six Lacs only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim.

Learned counsel for the appellants stated that agreed amount be released in favour of the appellant-Savitri Devi, the only legal heir of deceased-Satender pandey.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Companies to deposit cheque of Rs.36,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty Six Lacs only) (Rs.18 lacs each by both the Insurance Companies) in favour of the appellant-Savitri Devi with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 12.03.2026. Failing compliance of the order,

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interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.

Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
