1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of Award dated 07.01.2019 to the extent respondent No.1-Judicial Magistrate First Class-cum-Presiding Officer, Daily Lok Adalat, Kurukshetra has imposed condition of payment of double of cheque amount along with 10% of cheque amount as costs in case petitioner fails to make payment of Rs.15,00,000/- as per the compromise effected between parties. He is further seeking stay of execution proceedings.

2. As per pleadings, father of respondent No. 3 instituted a complaint against the petitioner under section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. Daily Lok Adalat vide Award dated 07.01.2019 disposed of the complaint in view of compromise arrived between parties. It imposed an additional condition that in case of failure of petitioner to make



the payment of Rs. 15,00,000/- as per the compromise, he shall be liable to pay double the amount of cheque along with 10% of cheque amount as costs. The complainant died on 14.06.2020 and respondent No. 2 & 3 being his legal heirs preferred execution petition before learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Kurukshetra on 28.09.2021. During the pendency of execution petition, the petitioner moved an application before respondent No.1 seeking correction of award dated 07.01.2019 to the extent of above-mentioned condition imposed on him which has been dismissed vide order dated 23.05.2025.

- 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petition may be dismissed as withdrawn as the matter has been amicably settled between the parties.
- 4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
- 5. Pending Misc. application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
