HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present appeal, the challenge is to the orders dated 19.12.2016 and 14.12.2016 passed by the learned Single Judge in CRWP No.1568 of 2016 to remove the condition relating to visitation rights to the respondent No.2-husband in the order to the extent wherein the appellant has been directed to handover the custody of ten months old child to respondent No.2 for 55 hours.

2. Learned counsel for the parties, in the presence of the appellant-mother, agree that the present appeal can be disposed of with the direction that respondent No.2-husband can meet the child on a particular Sunday with prior intimation to the mother of the child at a Gurudwara at Harindra Nagar Faridkot which is situated next to the house of the appellant-mother.



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3. Learned Senior Counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.2 and 5 submits that such intimation shall be given to the appellant-mother at least 24 hours prior to the time when respondent No.2 wants to meet the child.

4. Keeping in view the said agreement between the parties, the present appeal is disposed of with the observation that the orders passed by the learned Single Judge stands modified in terms of the agreement between the parties noticed hereinbefore.

5. Civil miscellaneous application pending if any, also stands disposed of.
