

**Daily Lok Adalat****Bench No.1**

It is worthwhile to mention here that vide the impugned award, the liability is fastened upon the United India Ins. Co. Ltd. and National India Insurance Company in equal shares.

On 21.04.2026, on behalf of the appellants statement (separately recorded), was made by learned counsel for the appellants to accept Rs.2,30,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh and Thirty thousand only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the MACT concerned, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. On the said date, learned counsel for the United India Ins. Co. Ltd. has given their concurrence to the aforesaid proposal to the extent of their share i.e. Rs.1,15,000/- and made a statement to that effect.

Today, learned counsel for the National Insurance Company Limited has given concurrence to the extent of their share i.e. Rs.1,15,000/- and made a statement to that effect

Accordingly, Rs.2,30,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh and Thirty thousand only) is allowed as further compensation over and above the compensation already awarded by the MACT. As per the statement of the learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellant No.2-Payal Meena (Now also LR No.1)

We dispose of this case with a direction to both the Insurance Companies as aforementioned to deposit two crossed-cheques in the sum of Rs.1,15,000/- (Rupees One Lakh and Fifteen thousand only) each in the name of



appellant No.2-Payal Meena (now also LR No.1) with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 15.06.2026 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellants' counsel/appellants may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
