JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to release payment with respect to work carried out by him for the respondent along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned State counsel on instruction from Mr. Sahab Singh, BDPO, Nilokheri submits that competent authority would consider petitioner's claim and if any admitted liability is found, it would be discharged within three months from today.

3. In the wake of statement of learned State counsel, the petition stands **disposed of** with a direction to respondent to release payment to the



petitioner within three months from today failing which would be liable to pay interest @ 9% per annum from the expiry of said period.
