VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. In the present appeal, two aspects have been highlighted by the counsel for the appellant. First aspect is with respect to quantum of compensation regarding which it has been stated by the counsel that the submissions have already been made in FAO-1875-2019 which have been duly considered and the said aspect has been decided and thus, on the said aspect, the present appeal need not be pressed further. The second aspect highlighted is with respect to non grant of recovery rights to the Insurance Company from the owner by the Tribunal.
2. Learned counsel for the appellant has very fairly submitted that since in spite of best efforts, appellant-Insurance Company has not been able to trace the whereabouts of the owner thus, the present appeal be disposed of but liberty be granted to the appellant to revive the present appeal on the said second aspect after the Insurance Company is able to trace out the latest whereabouts of the owner.
3. Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present appeal is disposed of with liberty aforesaid.
4. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
