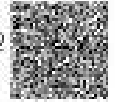

1. Learned counsel for the appellant submitted that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and the entire dues of respondents No.1 and 2 have been paid.

2. Learned counsel for respondents No.1 and 2 submitted that it is correct that the matter has been settled between the parties and respondents No.1 and 2 have received the entire amount.

3. Learned counsel for the appellant submitted that by way of the orders passed by this Court in the present appeal dated 26.05.2025 and 29.05.2025, the appellant was directed to deposit some amount before the learned Executing Court, which the appellant has deposited and the same has been kept in a Fixed Deposit. He further submitted that since the entire amount



has been paid to respondents No.1 and 2 excluding the said amount, the appellant may be permitted to withdraw the amount, which has been kept in the Fixed Deposit.

4. Learned counsel for respondents No.1 and 2 submitted that respondents No.1 and 2 has no objection to the aforesaid as their dues in this regard have already been satisfied.

5. Learned counsel for the appellant submitted that in view of the aforesaid statement made by the learned counsel for respondents No.1 and 2, he may be permitted to withdraw the present appeal with liberty to the appellant to file an appropriate application before the learned Executing Court in this regard.

6. The aforesaid request made by the learned counsel for the appellant is accepted.

7. The present appeal is dismissed as withdrawn. Liberty is granted to the appellant to file an appropriate application before the learned Executing Court for withdrawal/refund of the amount already deposited by it, which is kept in a Fixed Deposit in a Nationalized Bank. Upon doing so, the learned Executing Court shall pass an order with regard to refund of the said amount to the appellant.
