As agreed, as per statement of learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel and representative of the respondent-Insurance Company (separately recorded) a sum of Rs.7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants as full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellants.

Accordingly, we **dispose of** the present appeal with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a cross-cheque for Rs.7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs only) in the name of appellants with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within 45 days in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9 % per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order till the payment is made. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

The amount be remitted to appellant no.1. However, in case, any other claimant has any objection, they will be at liberty to claim the

same as per the apportionment done by learned concerned Tribunal vide order dated 12.01.2017.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.

Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
