JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to release payment including security with respect to work carried out by him for the respondent along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. Learned State counsel on instruction from Mr. Vijay Kumar, XEN, PHED-2, Sirsa and Mr. Ajay Dhaka, SDE submits that claim of petitioner is under consideration and admitted liability, if any, would be released within three months from today.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent may be subjected to interest @ 6% per annum from the date of passing bills.

4. In the wake of statement of both sides, the petition stands ***disposed of*** with a direction to respondent No.5 to release payment to the petitioner within three months from today along with interest @ 6% per annum from the date of passing bills. It is made clear that if payment is

not released within aforesaid period, the rate of interest would be 9% from the expiry of said period.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
