1. Controversy raised in the present writ petition stands finally adjudicated by this Court in CWP-10429-2020, decided on 28.01.2026.

2. Although, learned State counsel tries to distinguish the observations by contending that the order impugned is speaking one but we find that till paragraph 16 only the facts and contentions have been noticed. The petitioner's contention noticed in paragraph 14 that they could not operate mines as per its potentiality firstly on account of non-grant of EC in the part area by the Ministry of Environmental Clearance and Climate Change, Government of India and on account of orders passed by the NGT, have not been specifically dealt with.

3. In such view of the matter, we find that the controversy is covered by the earlier adjudication in CWP-10429-2020 (supra). However, in

order to facilitate fresh consideration of the claim in terms of the above observations, the order passed by the Director, Mines and Geology, Haryana, dated 06.08.2019, is quashed. Fresh decision shall now be taken within three weeks from today.
