SANJAY VASHISTH, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 for quashing of FIR No. 0008 dated 01.02.2020, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC at Police Station Sector 19, Chandigarh.
2. Learned counsel for U.T. Chandigarh has produced copy of order dated 13.01.2026 and submits that infact the discharge application is being pursued by the petitioner before the trial Court, therefore, instant petition is not maintainable.
3. Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to raise all the pleas before the trial Court, where the discharge application is to be argued.
4. The petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforementioned liberty.
