1. By way of this common order all the aforementioned petitions are being disposed of.

2. CRM-M-45773-2025 has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS by Happy alias Tota, seeking regular bail in case FIR No. 202, under Sections 302,323, 307, 148, 149, 341 IPC, registered at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.



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CRM-M-52780-2025 has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS by petitioner-Raja @ Raja Singh, seeking regular bail in case FIR No. 202, under Sections 302, 323, 307, 148, 149, 341 IPC (Section 201 IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

CRM-M-7135-2026 has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS by petitioner-Rahul @ Moju, seeking regular bail in case FIR No. 202, under Sections 302, 323, 307, 148, 149, 341 IPC (Section 201 IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

3. FIR was got registered by complainant-Ashok Singh, stating that at the time of the incident, i.e., on 02.11.2022, he along with his brothers, namely Puneet Singh and Sunny Singh, was going back to Sadavrat after filing an application in the office of SSP Rupnagar. At about 03:00/03:30 p.m., they were surrounded by the accused, namely (i) Ravi, (ii) Sahib Singh, (iii) Najar, (iv) Mauji, (v) Raja, (vi) Neelu, (vii) Happy @ Tota and some other unknown persons, who, while being armed, suddenly attacked the complainant.

4. Rahul @ Moji and Ravi gave kirpan blows on the head of Puneet; Sahib and Rahul @ Moji gave kirpan blows on the head and left arm of the complainant, Ashok Singh.

5. While the injured were lying on the ground, other accused persons also gave kirpan blows to them. Due to the injuries, Puneet died



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in the incident, whereas the complainant Ashok Singh and Sunny suffered serious injuries.

6. During the course of hearing, it has been informed by the learned counsel for the complainant and confirmed by the learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Pawan Kumar, that some of the accused, namely Sudesh @ Batta (son of petitioner Raja @ Raja Singh in CRM-M-52780-2025) and Bagla @ Bagga Singh (nephew of petitioner Happy @ Tota in CRM-M-45773-2025), who have been granted bail, used to threaten the witnesses and had also caused injuries to them by preventing them from recording their statements. Both the aforementioned accused, namely Sudesh @ Batta and Bagla @ Bagga Singh, are facing a case bearing FIR No. 267 dated 07.10.2025 under Sections 118(1), 191(3) and 190 of BNS, registered at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar, though they have been granted anticipatory bail.

7. Learned counsel for the complainant further submits that complainant-Ashok Singh, is yet to be examined in the witness box, whereas till date charges have not been framed.

8. In view of the above, present petitions are disposed of with a direction to the learned trial Court concerned to frame the charges on the next date of hearing and thereafter record the statement of the complainant and other material witness(es), if any, in the first instance.

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9. After the aforementioned exercise, it would be open for the petitioners herein to move fresh bail petition(s) before this Court.
10. Disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
11. A photocopy of this order be place on the files of other connected cases.
