1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari for quashing the order dated 24.05.2023 (Annexure P-1), whereby the petitioner has been transferred from Rajindra Hospital,- Government Medical College, Patiala to Government Medical College, Amritsar, where no post of senior assistant is vacant and rendered the petitioner without pay and allowances from May, 2023 onwards and acted in violation of transfer policy dated 23.04.2018 (Annexure P-7). Further, a writ of mandamus has been sought for issuance of directions to the respondents to immediately release the pay and allowances of the petitioner up-to-date and consider the posting of the petitioner after taking into account the representations dated 24.05.2023 and 02.08.2023 (Annexures P-2 and P-5 respectively) and, if required, transfer him to the nearby locations in terms of para 2 of the transfer

policy dated 23.04.2018 (Annexure P-7).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already retired from service. Therefore, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.

3. Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
