**ASHWANI KUMAR MISHRA, J. (ORAL)**

This writ petition was filed in the year 2023. Though the petitioner possessed the requisite eligibility for admission in M.Phil (Clinical Psychology) course, yet the University did not grant admission to the petitioner. This Court, vide a reasoned order passed on 09.11.2023, permitted the petitioner to be provisionally admitted to the course. With the passage of time, the petitioner has completed the course. It is at this stage that the matter has been placed before us for hearing.

Considering the fact that, pursuant to the interim order passed in the matter, the petitioner has already completed the course, we do not deem it necessary to adjudicate the matter any further at this belated stage.

The writ petition is disposed of with the observation that the result of the

petitioner for the M.Phill, (Clinical Psychology) two year course shall be declared by the University. The parties shall bear their own costs.

The disposal of this matter shall not be treated as a precedent in any other case.

Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
