SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (Oral)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 26.05.2025 passed by this Court in CWP-15280-2025 whereby without commenting upon the merits of the case, a direction was given to the respondents to take a decision on the representation dated 23.01.2024 submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order and after affording opportunity of hearing to all the concerned.
2. Learned State counsel submits that in compliance of the above referred to order, affidavit of the respondent dated 09.02.2026 has been filed along with copy of speaking order dated 27.08.2025 (Annexure R-1). The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at an appropriate place.
4. A perusal of the above affidavit shows that order dated 26.05.2025 passed by this Court in CWP-15280-2025 has been duly complied with.
5. In view of the above, the contempt is purged. Rule is *discharged*.
6. Needless to say that petitioner can avail any other remedy as is available to him, in accordance with law, to challenge the speaking order dated 27.08.2025.
