The instant appeal has been filed against the order dated 29.08.2025 passed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Amritsar in FIR No.89 dated 25.06.2025 under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 351(2), 191(3), 190 of BNS, 2023 and Section 3(2)(vi) of SC and ST Act, 1989 registered at Police Station Chattiwind, District Amritsar Rural, whereby the application for anticipatory bail filed by the petitioner has been dismissed.

A Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, vide order dated 12.09.2025, had directed the appellant to appear before Investigating Agency and join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the

conditions envisaged under Section 482(2) of the BNSS (erstwhile Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.)

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that in compliance of the order dated 12.09.2025 passed by this Court, the appellant has joined and cooperated with the investigation.

Learned State Counsel on instructions states that the appellant has joined the investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by learned State Counsel, the appeal is allowed and the interim order dated 12.09.2025 is hereby **made absolute**.

The appellant shall, however, continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
