The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to release the pensionary/terminal benefits viz. Family Pension, Gratuity, Provident Fund, payment on account of Deposit Linked Insurance Scheme and employee's share of accumulated pension corpus etc. to the petitioner, on account of death of her husband while in service, under Old Pension Scheme in view of Punjab

Government Policy dated 08.10.2021 (Annexure P-2) and Policy dated 05.02.2020 (Annexure P-3), and further give her consequent arrears thereof along with interest thereon @ 12% per annum.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the relief sought in the petition has already been granted by the respondents. Therefore, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
