Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for quashing of advertisements dated 05.11.2019 (Annexures P-3 to P-6), inviting applications for filling of backlog posts of Social Study/Punjabi/Hindi/Maths Masters/Mistresses to the extent of condition/requirement of 55% marks at graduation level for the said posts being contrary to original advertisement dated 10.09.2017 (Annexure P-2) and to consider the claim of the petitioners for the posts in question.

2. In view of the averments made in para 4 of the reply filed on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition.
