Having heard learned counsel for the applicant, this Court does not find any merit in the application filed on behalf of Kishan Singh, who is neither the complainant nor the affected party in the present FIR. Consequently, the application is dismissed.

Main case

Despite the matter having been called, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has informed that despite specific directions issued by this Court on 09.12.2019 and 10.02.2020, the

petitioner has not joined investigation. He has further informed that there are 5 other similar FIRs against the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid conduct of the petitioner, no special case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out. The petition, as such, is dismissed.
