The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in case bearing FIR No.77 dated 19.07.2025 registered under Sections 406 and 420 of IPC at Police Station City Nakodar, District Jalandhar (Rural).

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 02.04.2026, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. A cheque bearing No.010581 dated 08.04.2026 amounting to Rs.5,00,000/- has also been handed over to the complainant today in Court itself, who is present in Court.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 02.04.2026 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(3) of the BNSS, 2023.

Petition stands disposed of.
