1. The present contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 13.02.2025 passed by this Court in CWP-3960-2025, whereby direction was issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation filed by the petitioner by passing a reasoned and speaking order.

2. In compliance of the order dated 13.02.2025 passed by this Court in CWP-3960-2025, compliance report by way of affidavit dated 30.03.2026 of Suga E, IFS, Deputy Conservator of Forests, Kurukshetra, along with speaking order dated 24.03.2026 (Annexure R-1), has been filed on behalf of respondent No.2 before the Registry.
