1. The present third petition has been filed under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case arising out of FIR No.291 dated 09.12.2022, registered under Sections 302 and 201 of IPC (Sections 376, 120-B and 34 of IPC added later on) at Police Station Rampura, District Rewari.

2. Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate dated 18.03.2026, which is taken on record.

3. At the outset, learned State counsel submits that the trial is at the fag end and out of 44 prosecution witnesses, 31 have already been examined.

4. Faced with the aforesaid fact that the trial is at the fag end, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition



at this stage; however, he further prays that appropriate directions be issued to the learned Trial Court to decide the case expeditiously.

5. In view of the above and considering the fact that the trial is at the fag end, therefore, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage and the learned Trial Court is directed to make a positive endeavour to expedite and conclude the trial in accordance with law.

6. Pending application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
