Petitioner-Asim Vij has filed this petition under Section 528 of BNSS, for quashing the FIR No.544 dated 30.08.2023 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 406, 420 of the IPC, and, Section 24 of the Emigration Act, 1983, registered at Police Station Old Industrial area, District Panipat, along with all consequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the Compromise Deed dated 07.11.2024 (Annexure P-2).

2. At first instance, on 13.01.2025, parties were directed to get their statements recorded, however, neither any statement was recorded nor there was any representation before the Court and, therefore, on 25.04.2025, the petition was dismissed for want of prosecution.

On moving an application (CRM-22503-2025) for restoration, the main petition was restored and again a direction was issued on 29.05.2025 to get the statements recorded. However, thereafter none appeared on behalf

of the petitioner on 12.08.2025, 29.01.2026 and even today there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. Report dated 30.07.2025 also indicates that none of the parties appeared before the Court for getting their statements recorded.

4. **The petition is again dismissed for want of prosecution.**
