The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.07 dated 20.03.2025, under Section(s) 118(2), 115(2), 61(2), 3(5), 351(2), 351(3) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, registered at Police Station GRP, Jalandhar.

Status report already filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that pursuant to

the order dated 09.12.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner(s) has joined investigation and custodial interrogation of the petitioner(s) is not required for further investigation of the case.

Learned State counsel, on instruction from assisting police official, corroborates the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner(s) is not required for the purpose of investigation.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner(s) has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 09.12.2025 is made absolute.
