The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 BNSS, 2023 in case bearing FIR No.43 dated 13.07.2024 under Sections 118(1), 118(2), 190, 191(3), 351(2) of BNS, 2023 registered at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar Rural on the basis of a compromise dated 27.02.2025.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 14.10.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 14.10.2025 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 14.10.2025 is made absolute.



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However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

The petition stands disposed of.
