The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.226 dated 13.08.2025, under Section(s) 316 (2), 318(4) and 61(1) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, registered at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that pursuant to the order dated 04.11.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner(s) has joined

investigation and custodial interrogation of the petitioner(s) is not required for further investigation of the case.

Learned State counsel, on instruction from assisting police official, corroborates the said averment and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner(s) is not required for the purpose of investigation.

Since the petitioner(s) has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 04.11.2025 is made absolute.
