Prayer in the instant civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India *inter alia* is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Mandamus* for directing respondent No.2 (Director, Panchayat, Punjab) to take action against respondents No.5 to 8, who are Members of Gram Panchayat Dadial, Block Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur for their alleged absence from the Panchayat meetings, without any justifiable reason.

2. Mr. Nirmaljit Singh Diwana, Sr. DAG, Punjab, appears on behalf of respondents/State, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having already been supplied upon the State. He on instructions from Mr. Gurneet Singh Chahal, Block Development and Panchayat Officer,

Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur, submits that the concerned Block Development and Panchayat Officer has requisitioned a meeting of all the Members of Gram Panchayat on 16.02.2026, so as to consider the agenda about the development works of the village. He further submits that in case any Member remains absent from the said meeting without any justifiable reason, appropriate action would be taken, as per the attending circumstances, in accordance with law.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid stand taken by learned State counsel, no further orders are required to be passed in the present writ petition and the same is disposed of, accordingly.

4. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
