Prayer in the present application is for placing on record the affidavit dated 12.05.2026 filed on behalf of the respondents.

CWP-31824-2025 (O&M):

Petition herein is, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the official respondents to renew the petitioner's passport by setting aside the letter dated 19.02.2025 (Annexure P-5), issued by the Regional Passport Office, Delhi.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents informs the Court that pursuant to the application for renewal of passport submitted by the petitioner, the passport authorities had sought certain information/clarifications from the petitioner. However, since the petitioner failed to respond to the same, the said application stands closed as on date.

2.1 Learned counsel appearing for the respondents further submits that in case the petitioner files a fresh application seeking renewal of the passport, duly supported by all requisite documents/information, the same shall be considered and a final decision thereupon shall be taken by the competent authority (as the circumstances may warrant), in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of submission of such application by the petitioner.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel appearing for the respondents, no further orders are required to be passed in the present writ petition and the same is, accordingly, disposed of.

4. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
