The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 BNSS in case bearing FIR No.127 dated 21.09.2025 registered under Sections 308(2), 318(4) of BNS, 2023 at Police Station Satnali, District Mahendergarh, Haryana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 10.11.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.
