SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (Oral):

1. This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, in a case arising out of FIR No.282 dated 23.09.2023, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, Police Station Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.
2. Vide order dated 04.11.2025, the petitioner was admitted to interim anticipatory bail, subject to the condition of furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer.
3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance with above mentioned order, dated 04.11.2025, the petitioner has already joined investigation.
4. The learned State Counsel, on the instructions of ASI Baldev Singh, has submitted that in compliance with the order dated 04.11.2025, the petitioner has joined investigation, and that the custody of the petitioner is no



longer required for further investigation of present case.

5. In view of above, the order dated 04.11.2025, whereby interim anticipatory bail was accorded to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute.
