**SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (Oral):**

1. This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, in a case arising out of FIR No.234 dated 28.12.2020, under Section 36(1) of Punjab Apartment and Property Regulation Act 1995, Police Station Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur.
2. Vide order dated 11.11.2025, the petitioner was admitted to interim anticipatory bail, subject to the condition of furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer.
3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance with above mentioned order, dated 11.11.2025, the petitioner has already joined investigation.
4. The learned State Counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur. The same be taken on record. The learned State Counsel, on the



instructions of ASI Jasveer Singh, has submitted that in compliance with the order dated 11.11.2025, the petitioner has joined investigation, and that the custody of the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation of present case.

- 5. In view of above, the order dated 11.11.2025, whereby interim anticipatory bail was accorded to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute.
- 6. Present petition stands allowed, accordingly.
