AMAN CHAUDHARY, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the BNSS, 2023 for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.52 dated 27.04.2025, under Sections 221, 132, 127(2), 121(1), 351(2) and 3(5) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka.

2. On 11.11.2025, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.52 dated 27.04.2025 under Sections 221, 132, 127(2), 121(1), 351(2) & 3(5) of BNS registered at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. He was

allegedly armed with a stick and no grievous injury had been caused by him. The alleged injuries were on the non-vital part of the body. He has submitted that co-accused Kuldeep Singh has already been granted interim bail vide order dated 30.10.2025 of this Court. Petitioner is ready and willing to join investigation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Navdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and seeks time to file status report.

List on 16.02.2026.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/ Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 482(2) BNSS.”

3. Learned counsel submits that in pursuance of the aforementioned order, the petitioner has joined investigation. He further submits that in case the investigating agency requires the petitioner to appear, he shall make himself available without demur.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhpal Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 12.12.2025. He also submits that at this stage, the petitioner is not required for further custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, anticipatory bail petition filed by the petitioner is allowed and the order dated 11.11.2025 granting interim bail to him, is hereby made

absolute, subject to compliance of conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. (now 482(2) of BNSS, 2023)

6. However, it is made clear that if the petitioner fails to join and cooperate with the investigating agency as and when required, the State would be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of the present anticipatory bail granted to him.
