SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (Oral):

1. This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, in a case arising out of FIR No.140 dated 13.10.2025, under Section 15-B of Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 [Section 29 of NDPS Act added later on], Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar Rural.

2. Vide order dated 11.11.2025, the petitioner was admitted to interim anticipatory bail, subject to the condition of furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer.

3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance with above mentioned order, dated 11.11.2025, the petitioner has already joined investigation.

4. The learned State Counsel, on the instructions of ASI Charanjit Singh, has submitted that in compliance with the order dated 11.11.2025, the



petitioner has joined investigation, and that the custody of the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation of present case.

5. In view of above, the order dated 11.11.2025, whereby interim anticipatory bail was accorded to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute.
