SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (Oral)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 05.03.2025 passed by this Court in CWP-22954-2024, whereby, direction was issued to the respondent to decide the claim of the petitioner.
2. Learned counsel for respondent contends that in compliance of order dated 05.03.2025, affidavit of Mr. Amar Deep Singh, Registrar Cooperative Societies, Haryana, dated 20.01.2026, along with translated copy of order issued by DRCS, Kurukshetra for rescinding of resolution dated 04.12.2025; translated copy of directions issued by Registrar Cooperative Societies, Haryana, dated 16.12.2025; translated copy of letter issued by the society for relieving Sh. Sandeep Tanwar, dated 16.12.2025 and translated copy of order for suspension of President and Vice-President



of the Society dated 17.12.2025, has been filed. The same is taken on the record.

3. A perusal of the same shows that order dated 05.03.2025 passed in CWP-22954-2024 has been complied with. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.

4. In view of the same, the contempt is purged and rule is discharged.

5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
